ORDER GRANTING STAY

On July 9, 1998, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Ms. Johanningmeier's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. Ms. Johanningmeier was permitted to petition the board for a three month stay upon demonstration of her participation in an approved drug treatment program. The Order provided for successive three-month stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with certain conditions and limitations on the license. Among these were that Johanningmeier continue participation in a recognized program for the treatment of chemical dependency, that she participate in psychotherapy a minimum of four times each month, and that she participate in program of random witnessed monitoring for controlled substances and alcohol in his blood or urine on a frequency of not less than once per week.

By letter dated August 3, 1998, Ms. Johanningmeier requested that the board grant a stay of the suspension of the license. Included was evidence of her participation in a satisfactory drug treatment program. The board considered the request at its meeting of September 18, 1998, and granted the request by its Order dated September 28, 1998.

On July 9, 1999, the board considered a further extension of the stay of the suspension of Ms. Johanningmeier's license. Based upon all evidence of record herein, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Johanningmeier be, and hereby is, granted a three month stay of the suspension of her license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that further three month stays of the suspension of Ms. Johanningmeier's license shall be granted upon satisfactory demonstration by Ms. Johanningmeier of full compliance with all terms and conditions set forth in the board's Final decision and Order in this matter dated July 9, 1998, during the preceding three month period.
