The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Beauty Nails of Milwaukee, 1304 W. Lincoln Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53215, is duly licensed as a manicuring establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #1296). This license was first granted on September 21, 1998. Ngan Huy Vo is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Beauty Nails of Milwaukee. As owner, Mr. Vo is and was at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.

2. On exact dates unknown, but at least on November 12, 1998, Beauty Nails of Milwaukee neither disinfected reusable manicure instruments prior to use on patrons nor disposed of the manicure instruments that could not be cleaned and disinfected.

3. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Vo consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 2, above, Ngan Huy Vo, d/b/a Beauty Nails of Milwaukee, violated sec.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Ngan Huy Vo, d/b/a Beauty Nails of Milwaukee, shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondent fails to timely submit any payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Beauty Nails of Milwaukee (#1296) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
