The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Beverly Iverson (DOB 10-24-49) is duly licensed as a licensed practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #8280). This license was first granted on November 8, 1968.
- 2. Ms. Iverson's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 13106 7th St., P.O. Box 185, Osseo, WI 54758.
- 3. On March 1, 1998, Ms. Iverson's nursing registration expired. Ms. Iverson did not renew her registration until on or about September 10, 1998. Ms. Iverson admits she worked as a licensed licensed practical nurse at Midelfort Clinic, 674 8th St., Osseo, WI during the time her license was expired.

- 4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Iverson consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Beverly Iverson, by the conduct described above, has violated sec. 441.07(l)(b), Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.04(15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Beverly Iverson, is **REPRIMANDED**.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, Ms. Iverson shall pay the costs of this proceeding in the amount of SEVENTY-FIVE dollars (\$75.00).
