The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Angela L. Shabazz (DOB 06-04-63), P.O. Box 16239, Milwaukee, WI 53216 is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology practitioner in the state of Wisconsin (license #72889). This license was first granted on November 2, 1992.
- Kiss & Make-Up, 5500 W. Capitol Dr., Milwaukee, WI 53216, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #23151). This license was first granted on December 13, 1993.
- On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in February 1997 and continuing on through May 22, 1997, Angela L. Shabazz rented a chair at Kiss & Make-Up. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. Shabazz hold a barbering and cosmetology establishment license for the chair she was renting from Kiss & Make-Up.
- In resolution of this matter, Ms. Shabazz consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Angela L. Shabazz violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04 and BC 3.03(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Angela L. Shabazz shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within thirty (30) days of the date of this order. Payment shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Angela L. Shabazz fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the practitioner license of Ms. Shabazz (#72889) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
