The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Francine Shanks (DOB 04-21-63), 3811 N. 4th St., Milwaukee, WI 53212 is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin (license #19003). This license was first granted on January 9, 1989.
2. Francine’s Salon, 5500 W. Capitol Dr., Milwaukee, WI 53216, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #26427). This license was first granted on May 29, 1997. Francine Shanks is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner and manager of Francine’s Salon.
3. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in February 1997 and continuing on through May 29, 1997, Francine Shanks rented a chair at Kiss & Make-Up. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. Shanks hold a barbering and cosmetology establishment license for the chair she was renting from Kiss & Make-Up.
4. On exact dates unknown, but at least in January 1998, Francine Shanks rented a chair at Center of Attraction, a licensed barbering and cosmetology located at 4343 N. 60th St., Milwaukee, WI 53216. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. Shanks hold a barbering and cosmetology establishment license for the chair she was renting from Center of Attraction.
5. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Shanks consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶¶ 3 and 4, above, Francine Shanks violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04 and BC 3.03(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Francine Shanks shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a

forfeiture of TWO HUNDRED dollars (\$200.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days of the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Francine Shanks fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the manager license of Ms. Shanks (#19003) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
