The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Matthew J. Najieb (DOB 3-19-68) 3208 N. 47th St, Milwaukee, WI 53216, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology practitioner in the state of Wisconsin (license #76989). This license was first granted September 29, 1997.
2. Excell's House of Style, 3208 N. 47th St, Milwaukee, WI 53216, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #18743).
3. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least on February 14, 1997 and continuing on through at least June 6, 1997, Matthew J. Najieb was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Excell's House of Style. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Najieb hold a valid and current Wisconsin barbering and cosmetology license.
4. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Najieb consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Matthew J. Najieb violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Matthew J. Najieb shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:
