The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Crommie Lee Cole (D.O.B. 02-21-26), 2535 W. Center St., Milwaukee, WI 53206, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin (license #22087). This license was first issued on May 20, 1980 and expired on June 30, 1997.
2. Cole’s Appointment Barber Shop, 2535 W. Center St., Milwaukee, WI 53206, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #18254). This license was first granted on May 20, 1980. Crommie Lee Cole is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner and manager of Cole’s Appointment Barber Shop. As owner and manager, Mr. Cole was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on July 23, 1998, Crommie Lee Cole provided barbering and cosmetology services at Cole’s Appointment Barber Shop. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Cole hold a current and valid barbering and cosmetology license.
4. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least on September 11, 1997 and continuing on through at least July 23, 1998, Rickey L. Robinson was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Cole’s Appointment Barber Shop. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Robinson hold a valid and current Wisconsin barbering and cosmetology license.
5. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Cole consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3-4, above, Crommie Lee Cole, d/b/a Cole’s Appointment Barber Shop, violated sec. 454.04(1)(a), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Crommie Lee Cole, d/b/a Cole's Appointment Barber Shop, shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE THOUSAND dollars (\$1000.00). Payment shall be submitted as follows:

\$250.00 due on or before April 15, 1999;

\$250.00 due on or before June 15, 1999;

\$250.00 due on or before August 15, 1999; and

\$250.00 due on or before October 15, 1999.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondents fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Cole's Appointment Barber Shop (#18254) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
