The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times relevant to this action, Carol J. Krupke has owned and operated a barbering and cosmetology establishment in Monroe, Wisconsin (license #22597). This establishment license was first granted on March 31, 1993.
3. On exact dates unknown and at least on October 30, 1998, Ms. Krupke’s establishment. routinely used Barbicide and alcohol to clean and disinfect manicuring instruments, but failed to utilize a disinfectant registered with the United States environmental protection agency as a tuberculocidal agent as required by Wis. Admin. Code §BC4.10. This violation was promptly corrected, following notice from the Department of Regulation and Licensing.
4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Krupke consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 4, above, Respondent violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §BC 4.10.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Carol J. Krupke shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:
