The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent David P. Shepardson, (dob 12/16/1941) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a registered pharmacist licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #8746, originally granted on 1/9/1975.
2. Respondent is medically unable to practice as a pharmacist, and it does not appear that he will become able to practice in the foreseeable future. He desires to surrender his license.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The Board is authorized to accept the surrender of respondent's registration to practice pursuant to § 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The stipulation of the parties is accepted.
1. The SURRENDER by David P. Shepardson of his license of his license to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin is ACCEPTED.
1. Respondent shall not practice pharmacy in Wisconsin unless he is currently licensed. If respondent ever re-applies for a license to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin, he shall, in addition to all other requirements for licensure, demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Pharmacy Examining Board that he does not have any mental or physical condition which may interfere with his ability to practice, including but not limited to any chemical dependence, and that he can practice pharmacy with skill and safety to patient and public.
