The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Hair Masters, 4384 N. 27th St., Milwaukee, WI 53209, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #16216). This license was first granted on February 10, 1986. Reginald Brown is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Hair Masters. As owner, Mr. Brown was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
2. On exact dates unknown, but at least on June 19, 1997, Maurice Valentine was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Hair Masters. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Valentine hold a current barbering and cosmetology license.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on June 19, 1997, Curtis Dillard was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Hair Masters. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Dillard hold a current barbering and cosmetology license.
4. On exact dates unknown, but at least on June 19, 1997, Theresa George was providing barbering and

cosmetology services at Hair Masters. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. George hold a current barbering and cosmetology license.

5. In resolution of this matter, Reginald Brown, d/b/a Hair Masters, consents to the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶¶ 2-4, above, Reginald Brown, d/b/a Hair Masters, violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Reginald Brown shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of THREE HUNDRED dollars (\$300.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of this order and shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Reginald Brown fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Hair Masters (#16216) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
