The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. BobAnn Richmond (DOB 02-03-44) is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin (license #26201). This license was first granted on September 15, 1995. Ms. Richmond's address on file with the Department is 10411 W. Jonen St., Milwaukee, WI 53224. The latest address known to the Division of Enforcement for the respondent is 5633 N. 86th St., Milwaukee, WI 53225.
2. Hair Regulators II, Inc., 4411 N. 60th St., Milwaukee, WI 53218, was duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #26166). This license was first granted on January 17, 1997 and expired on June 30, 1997. BobAnn Richmond is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the manager of Hair Regulators II, Inc. As manager, Ms. Richmond was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 3 and 4.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on February 26, 1997, Darryl Tucker was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Hair Regulators II, Inc. At no time relevant to this action was Mr. Tucker indentured as an apprentice to Hair Regulators II, Inc.
4. On exact dates unknown, but at least on February 26, 1997, Nate Hogans was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Hair Regulators II, Inc. At no time relevant to this action was Mr. Hogans indentured as an apprentice to Hair Regulators II, Inc.
5. On exact dates unknown, but at least on February 26, 1997, Corey Johnson was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Hair Regulators II, Inc. At no time relevant to this action was Mr. Johnson indentured as

an apprentice to Hair Regulators II, Inc.

6. On exact dates unknown, but at least on February 26, 1997 and May 16, 1997, Anthony Latimore was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Hair Regulators II, Inc. At no time relevant to this action was Mr. Latimore indentured as an apprentice to Hair Regulators II, Inc.

7. In resolution of this matter, BobAnn Richmond consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶¶ 3-6 above, BobAnn Richmond violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that BobAnn Richmond shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of FOUR HUNDRED dollars (\$400.00). Payment shall be submitted within 45 days of the date of this Order and shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event BobAnn Richmond fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the manager license of Respondent (#26201) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
