The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Laura L. Dobbe (D.O.B. 1/20/58) is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse (license # 121119). This license was first granted on September 14, 1995.
2. Respondent’s latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is P.O. Box 98, Rosholt, WI 54473.
3. At all times relevant to this action Respondent was employed as a registered nurse at the Amherst Family Medical Center.

4. In October, 1998, Respondent ordered laboratory tests (for CBC and Mono) for a patient without a physician order or consent.

In May, 1999, Respondent obtained prescription drugs containing bultabital from samples at the Plover office of the clinic for her personal use without a valid prescription order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Laura L. Dobbe is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 441.07(1)(b) and (d), and Wis. Adm. Code sec. N 7.04 (1), (2), (5) and (15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that :

1. Laura L. Dobbe is REPRIMANDED for her unprofessional conduct.
 1. The rights of a party aggrieved by this Decision to petition the Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth on the attached "Notice of Appeal Information".
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
