The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Nancy K. Vandervelde (DOB 05-15-51) P.O. Box 524, South Green Lake, WI 54941, is duly licensed as an aesthetician in the state of Wisconsin (license #301). This license was first granted on June 4, 1997.
2. European Bodyworks, 524 South St., Green Lake, WI 54941, is duly licensed as a aesthetics establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #220). This license was first granted on June 28, 1999. Nancy K. Vandervelde is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of European Bodyworks. As owner, Ms. Vandervelde was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in March 1999 and continuing on through June 27, 1999, Nancy K. Vandervelde operated European Bodyworks without an aesthetics establishment license.
4. On exact dates unknown, but at least on June 22, 1999, Nancy K. Vandervelde engaged in the unauthorized practice of aesthetics in an unlicensed establishment.
5. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Vandervelde consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶¶ 3-4, above, Nancy K. Vandervelde, d/b/a European Bodyworks, violated secs. 454.08(1)(b) and 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Nancy K. Vandervelde, d/b/a European Bodyworks shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of TWO HUNDRED dollars (\$200.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

Vandervelde fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of European Bodyworks (#220) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.
