The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lance A. Klug (DOB 11-28-49) is duly licensed as an auctioneer in the state of Wisconsin (license #176). This license was first granted on March 1, 1995.
2. Mr. Klug's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Auctioneer Board is W5725 Ralph Rd., Fort Atkinson, WI 53538.
3. On December 31, 1996 Mr. Klug's auctioneer license expired. Mr. Klug did not renew his license until on or about February 28, 1998.
4. On July 29, 1997 Mr. Klug practiced as an auctioneer. At no time relative to this action did Mr. Klug hold a valid or current Wisconsin auctioneer license.
5. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Klug consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Lance A. Klug, by the conduct described above, has violated sec. 480.08(1)(a), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Lance A. Klug is REPRIMANDED.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Mr. Klug shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of TWO HUNDRED dollars (\$200.00). Payment shall be made *by certified check or money order*, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and mailed to:

In the event Lance A. Klug fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the auctioneer license of Mr. Klug (#176) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

4. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
