The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed the Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Mardele L. Moore (d.o.b. 3/04/60) is duly licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (lic # 102111). This license was first granted on August 25, 1989.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is P.O. Box 318, Ferryville, WI 54628.
3. While on duty on November 18, 1997, as a registered nurse at Vernon Memorial Hospital, Viroqua, Wisconsin, Respondent diverted the controlled substance, meperidine, from her workplace for her personal use.
4. Respondent participated in the IPP program, but withdrew in September, 1999.
5. Respondent is not currently practicing as a nurse, and tenders the voluntary surrender of her license to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Mardele L. Moore is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 441.07(1)(b) and (d) and Wis. Adm. Code sec. N 7.04(1), (2) and (15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The stipulation of the parties is accepted.
2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Mardele L. Moore of her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin is accepted.
3. In the event Respondent shall ever re-apply for a license to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin, she shall, in addition to all other requirements for licensure, demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Board of Nursing that she does not have a chemical dependence, and that she can safely and reliably perform nursing functions.
4. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
