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ORDER REINSTATING FULL LICENSURE

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On January 22, 1998, the medical examining board issued its final decision and order in the above-captioned matter. By the board's order, Dr. Lawnicki was required to satisfactorily complete a home-study course in pharmacology and a clinical pediatric pharmacology fellowship at Mayo Clinic. Following completion of these requirements, Dr. Lawnicki's practice was to be monitored for a period of one year by a physician appointed by the board.

By letter dated June 8, 1998, Gilbert C. Lubcke, prosecuting attorney in the matter, recommended to the board that it appoint Arthur J. Ross, M.D. to fulfill the monitoring function. The board approved the appointment of Dr. Ross by its Order dated July 8, 1998.

On October 20, 1999, the board considered Dr. Lawnicki's request for a return to full licensure. Based upon that request, and upon evidence of Dr. Lawnicki's full compliance with the board's January 22, 1998, Final Decision and Order, the board orders as follows:

now, therefore, it is ordered that all limitations on the license of Clyde C. Lawnicki, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin are hereby terminated, and Dr. Lawnicki is restored to full licensure.
