The Hearing and Speech Examining Board considered this matter on March 6, 2000.

BACKGROUND

- 1. Respondent, Katyrose Chapman, 331 North 70th Street, Wauwatosa, Wisconsin 53213, was granted a license (#1945) to practice as a speech-language pathologist on March 26, 1999.
- 2. On March 24, 1999, the Board adopted a Final Decision and Order pursuant to a Stipulation signed by the respondent. The Board granted a license to respondent to practice as a speech-language pathologist subject to certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, a requirement that she complete at least 12 hours of continuing education in the area of ethics for health care providers within 10 months of the date of the Order.
- 3. On March 6, 2000, the Board received confirmation that Ms. Chapman completed the continuing education course work as required in its March 24, 1999, Order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that based upon full compliance with the Board's Final Decision and Order in this matter, the limitations and conditions placed on the license of Katyrose Chapman to practice as a speech-language pathologist in Wisconsin are removed, and respondent's license is restored to full licensure.

This order is effective on the date it is signed by a designee of the Board.
