ORDER REINSTATING LICENSURE

On September 7, 1990, the board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Ritter's license to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin be suspended for a period of two years, with provision for successive three month stays of the suspension conditioned upon certain conditions and limitations on her license. On July 29, 1992, the board denied further stays of the suspension of Ms. Ritter's license, and on December 4, 1997, the Minnesota Board of nursing revoked her license in that state.

On May 14, 1999, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered Ms. Ritter's request for guidance as to requirements to have her Wisconsin license reinstated. The board communicated to Ms. Ritter that she must first satisfactorily resolve the disciplinary matter in Minnesota. On March 3, 2000, the board considered evidence that Ms. Ritter's Minnesota license has been reinstated. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Mary Elizabeth Ritter, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Wisconsin, be, and hereby is, reinstated.
