ORDER GRANTING STAY OF SUSPENSION (MARCH, 2000)

On March 15, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Dennis H. Defenbaugh, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Order Reinstating Stay of Suspension and Limiting License* dated February 13, 1996, and a request modification of the *Order* to reduce the frequency of urine screens from the present four (4) times per month to two (2) times per month.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Dennis H. Defenbaugh, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9747 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. The request for a reduction in the frequency of urine screens is denied.

Please be advised that the submission of the next quarterly reports and petition for extension of stay of suspension are due on June 1, 2000.
