ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE

---

On May 3, 1996, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period, with provision for successive three-month stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with certain conditions and limitations on the license. Among these were that respondent participate in a recognized program for the treatment of chemical dependency, that she participate in psychotherapy, and that she comply with all terms and conditions imposed on her license by the Minnesota Board of Nursing by a Consent Order dated April 6, 1995.

On May 8, 1998, the board considered evidence of Ms. Drake's failure to comply with the conditions of her limited license. Specifically, Ms. Drake had not provided a report from her supervising health care provider since June, 1997, and had failed to report to the board that her employment at Luther Hospital had been terminated on January 12, 1998, as required by the board's Order. Moreover, Ms. Drake had failed to request a renewal of the stay of suspension of her license. Accordingly, the board on May 15, 1998, terminated the stay of the suspension of her license.

By letter dated June 1, 1998, Ms. Drake submitted an explanation of her failure to submit required reports to the board, and requested a further stay of the suspension of her license. The board considered the request at its meeting of July 9, 1998, and granted the stay by its Order dated July 18, 1998.

On May 19, 2000, the board considered Ms. Drake's request that all limitations on her license be terminated, and that she be reinstated to full licensure. Based upon Ms. Drake's request, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Anne Marie Drake, RN, to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Drake is reinstated to full licensure.
