The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Terri Lee Johnson (D.O.B. 8/18/56) is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse (license # 77186). This license was first granted on August 29, 1980.
2. Respondent’s latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 793 Highway 51 East, Stoughton, WI 53589.
3. While employed as a registered nurse at Memorial Community Hospital, Stoughton, Wisconsin, Respondent made the following medication administration and documentation errors:

On 1/23/99 Respondent recorded as dispensed 2 doses of hydrocodone, 5 mg, at 12:00 and 15:00 to patient RC on the narcotic control sheet. The patient had been discharged on that date at 9:00.

On 3/18/99 and 3/20/99, Respondent exceeded the physician's order in administering hydrocodone to patient AW. The physician's order reads: "hydrocodone – 1 tab Q 4 hours for pain, prn." Respondent administered 1 tab every 2 hours, thus doubling the dosage. This resulted in 9 medication errors during Respondent's duty shift.

4. Respondent has been previously disciplined by the Board of Nursing in case 92 NUR 052.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Terri Lee Johnson is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 441.07(1)(b) and (d), and Wis. Adm. Code sec. N 7.03(a) and (b) and N 7.04 (15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that :

1. Terri Lee Johnson is REPRIMANDED for her unprofessional conduct.
2. The rights of a party aggrieved by this Decision to petition the Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth on the attached "Notice of Appeal Information".
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
