ORDER IMPOSING SUSPENSION

Respondent

On January 19, 2000, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Dr. Ivanov was to take and pass the 44 hour course in Proper Prescribing of Controlled Substances sponsored by the Forensic and Educational Consultants of Margate, NJ. The deadline for completion of the course was ordered to be September 1, 2000.

On November 15, 2000, the board considered evidence that Dr. Ivanov had failed to submit evidence of having completed the required course. Under the terms of the board's Order, where there is probable cause to believe that Dr. Ivanov has violated the board's Order, the board may order that his license and registration may be summarily suspended. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Yakov Ivanov to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, is hereby suspended, effectively immediately.
