The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department. The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable, and the Respondent agrees to accept renewal of his Private Security Permit subject to the terms and conditions set forth below.

Accordingly, the Department of Regulation and Licensing in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about June 13, 1997, Jamal T. Beles (DOB 08-09-72) submitted an application for a Private Security Permit to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing. Mr. Beles' last known address is 2848 W. Wells, Apt. 301, Milwaukee, WI 53208.

2. In Mr. Beles' application materials, he indicated "No" in response to the following question:

Have you ever been convicted of a misdemeanor or a felony, or driving while intoxicated (DWI), in this or any other state, **OR** are criminal charges or DWI charges currently pending against you? If YES, complete and attach Form #2252.

3. On or about July 1, 1997, The Department of Regulation and Licensing approved Mr. Beles' application and granted him a private security permit (#30).

4. Subsequent to the issue of this permit, the Department was notified that Respondent was found guilty of a Misdemeanor crime.

5. Respondent was convicted of unemployment compensation fraud on May 28, 1997. A true and correct copy of the Criminal Complaint and Judgment of Conviction are attached to this Order as Exhibit A. Exhibit A is incorporated by reference into this Order.

6. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Beles consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The provision of false information in an application for a private security permit constitutes a violation of sec. 440.26(6)(a)3, Stats.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jamal R. Beles is granted renewal of his Private Security Permit, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Jamal T. Beles is **REPRIMANDED**.

2. Mr. Beles shall pay the **COSTS** of this proceeding in the amount of ONE FIFTY HUNDRED dollars (\$150.00). Payment shall be submitted as follows:

\$50.00 with the attached signed Stipulation [received];

\$50.00 due on or before a date thirty days following the effective date of this Order; and

\$50.00 due on or before a date sixty days following the effective date of this Order.

Payment shall be made by *certified check or money order*, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

3. In the event that Mr. Beles fails to submit his payment of costs, his Private Security Permit shall be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until such time as he has complied with the terms of this Order.

4. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
