The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Angela M. Hanaman (dob 5/09/66) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a certified respiratory care practitioner in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to certificate # 28-1205 first granted on June 24, 1992. Respondent is also licensed as a registered nurse.
2. On July 1, 1999, and while employed as a registered nurse at the Select Specialty Hospital, West Allis, Wisconsin, Respondent reported for duty with cocaine in her blood stream. A drug screen taken on that date was positive for cocaine metabolite.
3. Following an evaluation at Midwest Clinical Services on November 15, 1999, Respondent was diagnosed with cocaine abuse.
4. Respondent is the subject of an impaired professional order issued by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing on March 3, 2000 (a copy of which is attached hereto).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to §448.02(3), Wis. Stats. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to §227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
6. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, violated § Med 10.02(2)(h) and (p), Wis. Adm. Code. Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the certificate of Angela M. Hanaman to practice as a respiratory care practitioner in the state of Wisconsin is LIMITED, in that Respondent shall not engage in the practice of respiratory care unless she is in full compliance with all of the terms and conditions of the Final Decision and Order of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing dated March 3, 2000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to §448.02(4), Wis. Stats., if the Board determines that there is probable cause to believe that respondent has violated any term of this Final Decision and Order, the Board may order that the license and registration of respondent be summarily suspended pending investigation of the alleged violation.
