The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Revelations Hair Salon, 5268 N. 76<sup>th</sup> St., Milwaukee, WI 53218 is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #23612). This license was first granted on July 20, 1994.
2. Emile and Cathy Banks and Daven and Tanya Hines are listed as the owners of Revelations Hair Salon. As owners they are at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on December 10, 1999, Mark Harris was providing barbering and cosmetology services at Revelations Hair Salon. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Harris hold a valid and current Wisconsin barbering and cosmetology practitioners license.
4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent, by the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, has violated secs. 454.04(1) and 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04(1) and 2.06.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Revelations Hair Salon is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of FIVE HUNDRED dollars (\$500.00). Payment shall be as follows:

- \$100.00 due on or before April 1, 2000;
- \$100.00 due on or before May 1, 2000;
- \$100.00 due on or before June 1, 2000;
- \$100.00 due on or before July 1, 2000; and
- \$100.00 due on or before August 1, 2000.

**Payment shall be made by certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that in the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Revelations Hair Salon SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
