On May 19, 2000, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Ms. Pollack's license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within six months of the date of the Order, she complete 4 hours of course work in the area of nursing ethics.

On September 1, 2000, the board considered Ms. Pollack's request for reinstatement to full licensure. Based upon that request, and upon evidence of Ms. Pollack's having complied with the board's Order, the board orders as follows:

### <u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Irene Pollack, LPN, are terminated, and Ms. Pollack is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
