The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Daniel G. Nachtigal (DOB 12/18/52) 6433 Bridge Rd., #102, Madison, WI 53716, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin (license #16735). This license was first granted on January 7, 1985.
- Dan & Company Hair Designs, 100 Frost Woods Road, Monona, WI 53716, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #19440). This license was first granted on December 12, 1988. Daniel G. Nachtigal is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner and manager of Dan & Company Hair Designs. As owner and manager, Mr. Nachtigal was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
- On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least on July 1, 1997 and continuing on through at least February 16, 2000, Dan & Company Hair Designs was operating as a barbering and cosmetology establishment. At no time relevant to this action was Dan & Company Hair Designs licensed as a Wisconsin barbering and cosmetology establishment.
- On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least on July 1, 1997 and continuing on through at least February 16, 2000, Dan Nachtigal was providing barbering and cosmetology services to the public. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Nachtigal hold a valid and current Wisconsin barbering and cosmetology managers license.
- In resolution of this matter, Daniel G. Nachtigal, consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶¶ 3-4 above, Daniel G. Nachtigal, d/b/a Dan & Company Hair Designs, violated secs. 454.04(1)(a) and 454.08(1)(b), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04(1) and BC 3.01(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Daniel G. Nachtigal, d/b/a Dan & Company Hair Designs shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE THOUSAND dollars (\$1000.00). Payment shall be submitted within 60 days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Daniel G. Nachtigal fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Dan & Company Hair Designs (#1568) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.
