On June 22, 2000, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require, among other conditions, that Dr. Sparr participate in a drug treatment program, and submit to urine screens for alcohol and controlled substances a minimum of twice per week. One of the controlled substances required to be screened for is fentanyl.

On August 24, 2000, the board considered Dr. Sparr's request that fentanyl be dropped from the screening panel based on the fact that the laboratory in Arizona which is analyzing the urine samples does not normally test for fentanyl, and adding the test substantially increases the cost of the screen.

Based upon respondent's request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 16 of the Order set forth in the Final Decision and Order of the Medical Examining Board in the above-captioned matter dated June 22, 2000, is hereby modified to eliminate the reference to fentanyl.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other terms and conditions of the board's June 22, 2000, Order shall remain in full force and effect.
