The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Sharon Rose Suleski (DOB 09-15-43) is duly licensed as a practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #22307). This license was first granted on December 5, 1979.
- 2. Ms. Suleski’s most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is S51 W25529 Glendale Rd., Waukesha, WI 53189.
- 3. On May 1, 1999, Ms. Suleski’s nursing registration expired. Ms. Suleski did not renew her registration until on or about November 16, 1999. Ms. Suleski admits she worked as a licensed practical nurse at Congregational Home, 3150 Lilly Rd., Brookfield, WI 53005, during the time her license was expired.
- 4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Suleski consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Sharon Rose Suleski, by the conduct described above, has violated sec. 441.10(3)(b), Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.04(15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Sharon Rose Suleski, is **REPRIMANDED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, Ms. Suleski shall pay the costs of this proceeding in the amount of SEVENTY-FIVE dollars (\$75.00).
