On December 12, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("Order") dated July 11, 2000, case number LS 0007112 PHM, and that the board modify the *Order* allowing him to work as a pharmacist-in-charge with his prospective employer.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., is GRANTED a three month stay of the suspension of license #8852 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. Mr. O'Kray is advised that he may petition the board for modification of paragraph 2c(3) of the *Order* prior to completing 2000 hours of supervised practice upon the condition that he submit to the board supporting documentation from his prospective employer meeting the requirements of 2c(3) .
