The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Millard Bates Hair Elegance, 3072 N. 27th St., Milwaukee, WI 53210, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #28225). This license was first granted on May 4, 1999. Lyle McDowell is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Millard Bates Hair Elegance.
2. As the owner of Millard Bates Hair Elegance, Lyle McDowell was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on May 16, 2000, Millard Bates Hair Elegance did not maintain equipment, tools and implements used by licensees in a clean, sanitary and safe condition.
3. In resolution of this matter, Mr. McDowell consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Lyle McDowell, d/b/a Millard Bates Hair Elegance, violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 4.01(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Lyle McDowell, d/b/a Millard Bates Hair Elegance, shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Lyle McDowell fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Millard Bates Hair Elegance (#28225) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Mr. McDowell has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
