The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Chic Nails, 4003 Durand Ave., Racine, WI 53405, is duly licensed as a manicuring establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #1237). This license was first granted on June 17, 1998.
2. Tuan Nguyen, 4003 Durand Ave., Racine, WI 53405, is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Chic Nails. As owner and manager, Mr. Nguyen was and is responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and chs. BC 2, 3 and 4 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
4. An inspection of Chic Nails on May 17, 2000 resulted in a Notice of Compliance [Exhibit A] which cited several minor sanitation concerns.
5. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Nguyen consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶¶ 4 and 5, above, Tuan Nguyen, as owner and manger of Chic Nails, has violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats., and Wis. Admin. Code §§BC 2.06(2) and BC 4.01(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Tuan Nguyen, d/b/a Chic Nails (license #1237), is **REPRIMANDED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tuan Nguyen shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by *certified check or money order*, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Tuan Nguyen fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Chic Nails (license #1237) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
