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Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

1. Respondent Constantine Georgalan (dob 5/24/1935), is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a registered pharmacist licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #7002, originally granted on 9/16/1960. Respondent was a fill-in pharmacist at Pinnow Pharmacy at the time the incident below took place.
2. On 4/5/00, the respondent allowed an unlicensed person transfer a prescription to the mother of a patient without consultation. The respondent was the only pharmacist on duty. This resulted in the patient receiving a prescription intended for another patient.

B. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, violated § Phar 7.01(1)(e) and (em). Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to §227.51(3), Wis. Stats., and ch. RL 6, Wis. Adm. Code, if the Board determines that there is probable cause to believe that respondent has violated any term of this Final Decision and Order, the Board may order that the license of respondent be summarily suspended pending investigation of the alleged violation.
