The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed the Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Donna J. Darrey (D.O.B. 11/16/47) is duly licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (lic # 49317). This license was first granted on November 8, 1968.
2. Respondent’s most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 1924 Chatham Street, Racine, WI 53402.
3. On November 12, 1999, Respondent diverted Percocet® from supplies at All Saints Healthcare. Following assessment Respondent was admitted to the IPP program. In April Respondent mishandled Nubain and Phenergen at her place of employment. Respondent requested termination from the IPP program which was granted July 7, 2000.
4. Respondent is not currently practicing as a nurse, and tenders the voluntary surrender of her license to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Donna J. Darrey is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 441.07(1)(b) and (d) and Wis. Adm. Code sec. N 7.04(1), (2) and (15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The stipulation of the parties is accepted.
2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Donna J. Darrey of her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin is accepted.
3. In the event Respondent shall ever re-apply for a license to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin, she shall, in addition to all other requirements for licensure, demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Board of Nursing that he does not have a chemical dependence, and that she can safely and reliably perform nursing functions.
4. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
