The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

1. James M. Poehling (DOB 11-26-1948) is duly registered as a professional engineer in the state of Wisconsin (registration #15626). This license was first granted on May 14, 1976.

2. Mr. Poehling's most recent address on file with the Professional Engineers Section of the Board is 3733 Ebner Coulee Rd, LaCrosse, WI 54601.

3. On July 31, 1980, Mr. Poehling's professional engineer registration expired. Mr. Poehling did not renew his registration until on or about June 15, 2000. Mr. Poehling admits he worked as a professional engineer at First Supply Company, LaCrosse, Wisconsin during the time his license was expired.

4. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Poehling consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

James M. Poehling, by the conduct described above, has violated sec. 443.02(2) and (3), Wis. Stats.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

1. James M. Poehling, P.E. is REPRIMANDED.

2. The license of Mr. Poehling is LIMITED as follows:

a. Within thirty [30] days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of five hundred [\$500] dollars (past license fees and . **Payment shall be made via certified check or money order and shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing,** and mailed to Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, PO Box 8935, Madison WI 53708-8935.

b. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
