The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department Secretary. The Department Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department Secretary adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Nhu Thuy Nguyen, [2102 North 5th Street, Wausau, WI 54403] is not and was not at any time relevant to this action licensed to practice manicuring in the state of Wisconsin.
2. On exact dates unknown, but at least on or about September 5, 2000, respondent engaged in the practice of manicuring at Fancy Nails, an establishment located at D400 Wausau Center, Wausau, Wisconsin.
3. Ms. Nguyen understands that she needs a license to practice barbering and cosmetology in the state of Wisconsin. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Nguyen consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to sec. 440.21, Stats.
2. A license is required to practice manicuring in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to sec. 454.04(1)(d), Stats.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Respondent NHU THUY NGUYEN is ENJOINED and PROHIBITED as follows:

1. Respondent SHALL NOT PRACTICE OR OFFER TO PRACTICE BARBERING AND COSMETOLOGY in the state of Wisconsin unless and UNTIL she obtains a license from the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board.
2. **Violation of the above-order may result in a forfeiture of up to \$10,000.00 for each offense, and each day of a continued violation constitutes a separate offense.**
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
