On February 13, 1996, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. Mr. Kujawa has requested that the *Final Decision and Order* be modified to allow him to work an additional twelve hours per week as a pharmacist in charge, thus increasing his hours from sixteen to twenty eight hours as a pharmacist in charge. Mr. Kujawa has also requested an additional three month stay of suspension.

On April 11, 2000, the board considered the respondent's request for a modification of the *Order* and a three month stay of suspension. Based upon the foregoing and a review of the materials submitted by Mr. Kujawa in support of his request,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Gregory J. Kujawa, R.Ph., is hereby granted an additional three month stay of the suspension of license number 9508 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERD that the February 13, 1996, *Final Decision and Order* be hereby modified to allow the respondent to work an additional eight (8) hours per week as a pharmacist in charge for a total of twenty four (24) hours.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.
