ORDER GRANTING STAY OF

SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION OF ORDER

On October 11, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("Order") dated August 13, 1997. Mr. Schmitt also appeared before the board.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., is granted a one-month stay of the suspension of license #8852 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

1. Prior to the next regular meeting of the board scheduled for November 8, 2000, Schmitt shall cause to be submitted to the department monitor a letter from his treating doctor with a copy of the treating doctor's patient notes, pertaining to Schmitt's claimed telephone conversation with his treating doctor about Schmitt's use of Vicodin for the treatment of pain.
2. Under the terms of the *Order* the number of urine screens per month is increased to 8.
3. Schmitt shall apply for a further three-month stay of suspension at the next regular meeting of the board scheduled for November 8, 2000.
