ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE
By its Final Decision and Order dated March 26, 1998, the Medical Examining Board limited respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin to require that he take and satisfactorily pass a 45 hour course entitled Proper Prescribing of Controlled Dangerous Substances, sponsored by Forensic and Educational Consultants of Margate, NJ., and that he complete an educational program in medical recordkeeping to be designed and conducted by the University of Wisconsin Continuing Medical Education Program.
On March 23, 2000, the board considered evidence of Dr. Bolek's having satisfactorily completed the requirements imposed by the board's Order. Based upon that evidence,
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of George Bolek, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin are terminated, and Dr. Bolek is reinstated to full licensure.
