ORDER GRANTING STAY  
OF SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION  
OF ORDER  
(March 15, 2000)

On April 14, 1998, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. Among the terms and conditions were that Ms. Kuhrt participate in individual and/or group therapy sessions at least once a week. By a *Modification of Order* (February, 1999), the board reduced the required therapy sessions to not less than twice monthly. By a *Modification of Order* (August, 1999), the board reduced the required therapy sessions to not less than once monthly.

Ms. Kuhrt has requested a continued three month stay of suspension and that the required drug screening provided in the *Final Decision and Order* (April 1998), be reduced from six times to four times per month for the second year following respondent's resumption of practice. On March 15, 2000, the board considered the request and the supporting evidence.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a three month stay of suspension is granted. The request that the required drug screening provided in the *Final Decision and Order* (April 1998), be reduced from six times to four times per month for the second year following respondent's resumption of practice, is granted.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.
