ORDER GRANTING  
STAY OF SUSPENSION  
(MARCH, 2000)

On March 15, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by David L. Kleingartner, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated June 10, 1998, and for modification of the previously modified Order of the Board dated September 15, 1999 to allow him to work an additional 8 hours per week as pharmacist-in-charge.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that David L. Kleingartner, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8865 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. The further request for modification of the Order of September 15, 1999, is DENIED.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED, that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.

Please be advised that the submission of the next quarterly reports and petition for extension of stay of suspension are due on June 1, 2000.
