On June 14, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by David L. Kleingartner, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated June 10, 1998, for modification of the *Order* to allow an additional 8 hours per week acting as a pharmacist in charge.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that David L. Kleingartner, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8865 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. It is further ordered that the respondent is allowed to work an additional 4 hours per week as a pharmacist in charge for a total of 16 hours per week. No more than 8 hours may be worked consecutively as a pharmacist in charge. The respondent may open and close the pharmacy but may not open and close the pharmacy consecutively.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED, that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.

Please be advised that the submission of the next quarterly reports and petition for extension of stay of suspension are due on September 1, 2000.
