ORDER GRANTING STAY
On July 9, 1998, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter, by which Mr. Bremer's license to practice professional nursing in Wisconsin was indefinitely suspended. By the terms of the Order, Mr. Bremer is permitted to apply to the board for successive three month stays of the suspension upon submission of to the board of an evaluation by an addictionologist indicating that he is successfully participating in a treatment program acceptable to the board and that, in his or her opinion, Mr. Bremer may safely and reliab practice as a nurse.
At its meeting of March 5, 1999, the board considered Mr. Bremer's application for a stay of the suspension of h license, and denied the application by its Order dated March 8, 1999.
On May 19, 2000, the board considered Mr. Bremer's further request for a stay of the suspension of his license. Based upon that application, the board orders as follows:
<u>ORDER</u>
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Dennis E. Bremer, R.N. for a three month stay of the suspension of his license is granted. Mr. Bremer may petition for further three month stays, which shall be granted upon submission of satisfactory evidence that he has complied with all limitations on his license during the preceding three month period.
