On October 11, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by John R. Litzenberg, R.Ph., for a three month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated August 12, 1998, and a request for granting an additional 8 to 16 hours per week as a pharmacist in charge in addition to the 12 hours currently worked as a pharmacist in charge. Litzenberg also requested termination of controlled substances audits at his place of employment, and termination of the requirement of group therapy as provided for in the *Order*.

Based upon the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that John R. Litzenberg, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license number 10410 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. The request for termination of controlled substances audits is denied. The request for termination of the requirement of group therapy is granted. The request for an increase in the number of hours worked as a pharmacist in charge is granted, with an additional 4 hours per week allowed to total 16 hours per week as a pharmacist in charge. Litzenberg may not open and close the pharmacy on the same day or back to back.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.
