On February 12, 1999, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. Among the terms and conditions set forth in the board's order was that respondent's license to practice pharmacy was suspended for one year, effective on the first day of the month following the adoption of the order. On February 8, 2000, the board considered a request from respondent for reinstatement of his license. The board determined that the request should be granted.

Based upon the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the respondent's license is reinstated, effective March 1, 2000.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous February 12, 1999, *Final Decision and Order* of the board in this matter shall remain in full force and effect.
