ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On September 17, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Ms. Kennebeck's license to practice as a practical nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within 12 months of the date of the Order, she complete 8 hours of continuing education in the area of nursing assessments, and eight hours of C.E. in workload management. Ms. Kennebeck completed the coursework in assessment on December 15, 1998, but has not submitted an acceptable course on workload management. Accordingly, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Kennebeck shall have commenced the required coursework in workload management not later than 60 days from the date hereof, or shall be deemed in violation of the board's Order.
