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ORDER ACCEPTING SURRENDER

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On September 17, 1998, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within one year, she complete 18 hours of continuing education in the areas of wound management and nutrition management, and 12 hours of continuing education in the legal aspects of nursing. On May 19, 2000, the board considered Ms. L'Heureux's letter of March 30, 2000, by which she requests that the board accept the voluntary surrender of her license based upon her inability to complete the required continuing education. Based upon respondent's request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the board hereby accepts the surrender of the license of Brenda J. L'Heureux to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Wisconsin.
