ORDER DENYING
STAY OF SUSPENSION
(MARCH, 2000)

On March 15, 2000 the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated December 8, 1998.

Based upon the board's review and consideration of the submitted documentation and after the review and consideration of other evidence presented to the board, the board finds that Iverson has not complied with the terms and conditions set forth in the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated December 8, 1998, in that Iverson has tested positive for morphine as evidenced by the results of drug screen reports and accordingly:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., is denied a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8239 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, and that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph, license #8239, be and hereby is suspended from the practice of pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated December 8, 1998.
