ORDER DENYING REQUEST
FOR A STAY OF SUSPENSION

On November 4, 1998, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Board's order, Craig Moon's license to practice dentistry was suspended for a period of not less than five (5) years, with a provision for consecutive four-month stays of the suspension, provided he complied with certain conditions and limitations on the license. Those conditions included, in part, that he remain free of alcohol, prescription drugs and controlled substances not prescribed by a practitioner for a legitimate medical purpose, that he participate in an AODA rehabilitation program, and that he undergo random drug screenings.

Craig Moon petitioned the Board for a four-month stay of suspension on August 7, 2000.

At its meeting on September 6, 2000, the Board considered evidence of Mr. Moon's noncompliance with the terms of his limited license. Specifically, the Board reviewed the results of a urine screen taken on August 2, 2000. The results of the screening indicated the presence of ethanol in Mr. Moon's system.

Therefore, based upon the Board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the request of Craig W. Moon, D.D.S., for a stay of suspension of his dental license is DENIED.
