On December 12, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., that the required monthly urine screens as provided as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated August 12, 1998, and paragraphs 1 and 2, of the board's order of October 11, 2000, be reduced from eight to four, and that Moon be allowed to utilize his own designated witnesses for the witnessed collection of urine specimens required by paragraph 2b(4) of the *Order*.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the petition of Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the terms of the *Order* shall remain in effect, as modified by paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of the board's order of October 11, 2000.
